TO: Adult Services Outpatient Providers
TOPIC: Treatment Status Reports (TSR)

TSRs shall be provided to Justice Involved Clients. TSRs are to be provided on a monthly basis to the referring Court or agency with appropriate releases and consents in place. The TSR should provide information on the participation of the individual in treatment, his/her attendance and engagement in treatment, and any changes to the treatment plan which have been incorporated during the reporting month.

In addition, if there is a significant change in status of a participant, a TSR will be sent at any time during the month.

For Parolees:

TSR for those parolees that are associated with the State Parole system will also receive an initial TSR at the time that the individual is enrolled in the treatment program, release is signed, and then monthly thereafter. Parolees that are referred will also receive the attached "Referral Confirmation to Adult System of Care" notice for review and signature.
