### Description:

With the recognition that supervision is a distinct professional practice has come direction in the form of specific guidelines, practice standards, and research support. This course is designed to provide participants a framework of competency-based clinical supervision, critical components, and guided learning through vignettes and interactive problem-solving exercises. Content includes supervisory skills focused on efficacy, technique, and practice. Lecture, discussion, videos and experiential exercises are included.

### Objectives: Participants will:

- Describe the use of one supervision guideline to anchor supervision practice.
- Identify three aspects of supervisor multicultural competence.
- Describe which competency is most addressed in supervisee remediation plans.
- Identify one guiding principle to proactively address value conflicts in supervision.
- Identify one ethical dilemma in supervision relating to social media and steps to problem solve with supervisee.
- Demonstrate understanding of one legal issue in identification and remediation of behavior of a supervisee who does not meet performance criteria.
- Describe two warning signs in supervisee behavior that indicate that a supervision rupture or strain has occurred.
- Identify three parts of the learning cycle.
- Describe the role of mindfulness in management of reactivity.
- List two evidence-supported self-care strategies for supervisees.
